ICC AND CRICKET AUSTRALIA'S POLICY STATEMENT ON INAPPROPRIATE CONDUCT

You must not engage in any conduct (whether through the use of language, gestures or otherwise) which is likely to offend, insult, humiliate, intimidate, threaten, disparage or vilify any other person (including players, match officials, other officials or spectators) on the basis of their race, religion, culture, colour, descent, nationality, ethnic origin, sex, gender, sexual orientation, disability, marital status and/or maternity status.

Such conduct will not be tolerated. You acknowledge that the failure to comply with this Policy Statement may result in the imposition of other sanctions (such as being banned from the Venue in the future) and possible further action including without limitation criminal prosecution.

Further, under the Ticket and Entry Conditions, you may be refused admission to, or evicted from the Venue without refund or compensation of any kind; and you must deliver up any and all tickets that you have in your possession.
